The *No Child Left Behind Act of 2001* (NCLB) requires schools to meet annual measurable objective (AMO) goals each year in reading/language arts and mathematics. Schools that do not meet the AMO objectives for both reading and math are identified and are required to develop, implement, and monitor a plan for improvement. Sandlick Elementary has been identified as a Title I School that has missed one or more objective.

The school is working to improve academic performance by using a Multi-Tiered Instructional Model (M-TIM) for the improvement of reading and math achievement. Additionally, the Virginia Department of Education and the school division are working with your child's school to improve the academic performance of the school.
